Grade F and G currently have the same mark-ranges (paragraph 69) and the same principle may apply to all three new grades Treating 10 per cent as the highest feasible mark for Ungraded as usually at present and dividing 11 to 55 marks in three equal mark-ranges of 15, grade 1 would require 11 - 25 per cent, grade 2 = 26 - 40
